Etiquette & Tradition

It's only natural to want your big day to run smoothly, so here's our simple guide to help. Remember this is only a guide and can be amended to suit your tastes.

The Receiving Line

The purpose of a receiving line is to allow the hosts and other members of your bridal party to officially welcome all your guests.

The Traditional Line Up

The Top Table

The top table should face your guests with the seating arrangement as shown below.

The Speeches

The speeches form an integral part of the wedding reception and traditionally follow the meal but come before the cutting of the cake. The traditional speakers at a formal wedding reception, in their correct order, are:

- The Bride's Father (or a close family friend).
- The Bridegroom
- The Best Man

In these days it is likely that people other than those listed above may want to make a speech. The most usual of these is the bride herself. There is absolutely no reason why the bride should not speak at her wedding.

Cutting the cake

At British weddings, it is usual for the Bride and Groom to cut the cake together. The cake cutting ceremony traditionally concludes the formalities and follows the toasts while everyone is still relatively quiet.

It is traditional to save some slices of cake to give to family and friends who were not able to attend the wedding.
